REGULATIONS

FOR THE "ICEBREAKER OF KNOWLEDGE 2026" NORTH POLE EXPEDITION

These regulations define the arrangements for the "Icebreaker of Knowledge 2026" North Pole expedition, including the procedures, conditions, and deadlines for the participation in the Expedition.

The Expedition is aimed at conducting educational activities dedicated to the nuclear industry for Expedition participants who qualify for participation in the Expedition (hereinafter referred to as the "Expedition Participants"). Participation in the Expedition does not involve generation of income by Expedition Participants; it is an educational event aimed at fostering a positive image of the nuclear industry, scientific activity, intellectual and engineering work, as well as modern high-tech and blue-collar professions within the industry among the younger generation.

By participating in the Expedition, Expedition Participants fully agree to these Expedition Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulations").

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. Full name: "Icebreaker of Knowledge 2026" North Pole Expedition (hereinafter referred to as the "Expedition"),

1.2. The territory of the Expedition covers the entire territory of the Russian Federation and the international waters of the Arctic.

1.3. The organizer of the Expedition is: Communications Center, a private institution for the implementation of communications programs in the nuclear industry (abbreviated name: Communications Center, private institution), INN: 9705152344, KPP (Tax Registration Reason Code): 770601001, located at: 24 Bolshaya Ordynka Street, intracity territory of a federal city Yakimanka Municipal District, 119017, Moscow (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer" or "Expedition Organizer").

1.4. Expedition Route: Murmansk – North Pole – Murmansk.

1.5. The Expedition will take place aboard the nuclear-powered icebreaker 50 Let Pobedy (hereinafter referred to as the "Icebreaker").

1.5.1. The entity responsible for transporting the Expedition Participants on the Icebreaker, for ensuring the safety of the Expedition Participants on board the Icebreaker, and for the operation and maintenance of the nuclear icebreaker fleet is the Federal State Unitary Enterprise of the Atomic Fleet (abbreviated name: FSUE Atomflot), INN: 5192110268, KPP: 519001001, address: Murmansk-17, Building 1, 183038, Murmansk Region.

All Expedition Participants are obliged to comply with FSUE Atomflot's requirements regarding rules of conduct and safety regulations on the premises of FSUE Atomflot and aboard the Icebreaker. FSUE Atomflot will communicate these rules and requirements to the Expedition Participants on the first day of the Expedition.

1.6. The Expedition Organizer has the right to engage co-organizers to assist in arranging the Expedition. Co-organizers of the Expedition are legal entities registered in accordance with the procedure established by the legislation of the Russian Federation, individual entrepreneurs, and self-employed persons (hereinafter referred to as "Co-organizers") participating in arranging the Expedition.

1.7. Dates of the Expedition.

Dates of the Expedition: from August 4, 2026 through August 13, 2026 (inclusive).

1.8. In the event that the Expedition cannot take place or its dates (or conditions) must be rescheduled for reasons beyond the Organizer's control (including, but not limited to, force majeure, natural disasters, decisions by local government bodies and/or federal authorities to impose quarantine measures or to close regions, political events, or decisions made by FSUE Atomflot), the Expedition Participants will be further informed by the Organizer or Co-organizers.

1.9.

2. PREPARATION FOR THE EXPEDITION

2.1. Expedition Participants are required to have the following set of documents prior to the start of the Expedition:

2.1.1. For Expedition Participants who are minors and citizens of the Russian Federation:

- a document proving the Expedition Participant's identity (a Russian passport for individuals aged 14 and older);
- a copy of a document proving the identity of the Expedition Participant's parent or legal representative (Russian passport), a copy of a document confirming kinship with the Expedition Participant, or a document confirming the legal authority to represent the Expedition Participant's interests (whichever was used to sign the documents on behalf of the Participant);
- a valid compulsory health insurance policy;
- consent from the parent/legal representative of the Expedition Participant to the Participant's participation in the Expedition, to the processing of the Expedition Participant's personal data, and to the processing of personal data authorized by the data subject for disclosure (using Forms Nos. 1-3 attached to these Regulations);
- consent from the parent/legal representative of the Expedition Participant to the photo and video recording of the Expedition Participant and the publication of such materials (using Form No. 5 attached to these Regulations);
- notarized consent from the parent/legal representative of the Expedition Participant to participation in the Expedition, specifying the dates of the Expedition (using Form No. 4 attached to these Regulations);
- a certificate from an educational institution confirming enrollment at that institution;
- medical documentation, in accordance with the List of Medical Documentation Required for Participation in the Expedition (Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations).

2.1.2. For Expedition Participants who are adult citizens of the Russian Federation:

- a Russian passport;
- a valid compulsory health insurance policy;
- the Expedition Participant's consent to the processing of the Expedition Participant's personal data and to the processing of personal data that the data subject has authorized for disclosure (using Forms No. 6 and No. 7 attached to these Regulations);
- the Expedition Participant's consent to the photo and video recording of the Expedition Participant and further use of such materials (using Form No. 8 attached to these Regulations);
- medical documentation, in accordance with the List of Medical Documentation Required for Participation in the Expedition (Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations).

2.1.3. For adult foreign Expedition Participants (adult foreign Expedition Participants are defined as persons who have reached the age of 18 as of August 1, 2026):

- a foreign passport proving the identity of the adult foreign Expedition Participant (or another valid document proving the identity of the foreign Expedition Participant and recognized by the Russian Federation as such, and a visa, unless otherwise provided for by the international treaties of the Russian Federation, the Federal Law, or decrees of the President of the Russian Federation);
- a document confirming that the foreign Expedition Participant is insured against risks of damage to life and health for the entire duration of the Expedition;
- medical documentation, in accordance with the List of Medical Documentation Required for Participation in the Expedition (Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations);
- the Expedition Participant's consent to the processing of the Expedition Participant's personal data and to the processing of personal data that the data subject has authorized for disclosure (using Forms No. 6 and No. 7 attached to these Regulations);
- the Expedition Participant's consent to the photo and video recording of the Expedition Participant and further use of such materials (using Form No. 8 attached to these Regulations).

2.1.4. For minor foreign Expedition Participants (minor foreign Expedition Participants are defined as persons between the age of 14 and 18):

- a foreign passport proving the identity of the minor foreign Expedition Participant (or another valid document proving the identity of a foreign national and recognized by the Russian Federation as such, and a visa, unless otherwise provided for by the international treaties of the Russian Federation, the Federal Law, or decrees of the President of the Russian Federation);
- a document confirming that the minor foreign Expedition Participant is insured against risks of damage to life and health for the entire duration of the Expedition;
- medical documentation, in accordance with the List of Medical Documentation Required for Participation in the Expedition (Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations);
- consent from the parent/legal representative of a minor foreign Expedition Participant to the Participant's participation in the Expedition, to the processing of the Expedition Participant's personal data, and to the processing of personal data authorized by the data subject for disclosure (using Forms No. 1-3 attached to these Regulations);
- consent from the parent/legal representative of a minor foreign Expedition Participant to photo and video recording of the Expedition Participant and further use of such materials (using Form No. 5 attached to these Regulations);
- a notarized consent from the parent/legal representative of a minor foreign Expedition Participant authorizing the minor's participation in the Expedition, specifying the dates of the Expedition (using Form No. 4 attached to these Regulations), accompanied by a notarized translation into Russian.

The Expedition Organizer and Co-organizers have the right to request additional documents from Expedition Participants regarding the health of the relevant Expedition Participant, which may be issued within the territory of the Russian Federation.

2.2. At the same time as submitting the above-mentioned documents, parents/legal representatives are required to notify the Organizer or the relevant Co-organizer (depending on which of them provides supervision during the Expedition) in writing of any health issues affecting the Expedition Participant, including, but not limited to: any necessary dietary restrictions, water intake requirements, allergic reactions, chronic conditions, potential acute conditions, and typical health issues; provide a clear (hour-by-hour) list and schedule of medications to be taken (quantities, dosages) and the medications themselves (with extra medications to be safe).

The Organizer or Co-organizer has the right to request a medical report. Parents/legal representatives are also required to disclose any bad habits they are aware of (alcohol, tobacco use, drug use, etc. on the part of the Expedition Participant), as well as any behavioral disorders, including suicidal tendencies.

2.3. At the same time, when handing over the child to the Expedition, parents/legal representatives are required to provide the authorized representative of the Organizer/Co-organizer (depending on which of them provides supervision during the Expedition) with a complete set of medications taken by the Expedition Participant (cl. 2.2. of the Regulations), which is necessary for the entire duration of the Expedition, including transfer days.

2.4. Contraindications for participation in the Expedition (i.e., grounds for exclusion from the Expedition) include:

- acute diseases;
- conditions requiring ongoing monitoring by attending physician;
- chronic conditions in the acute stage;
- injuries resulting in impaired mobility;
- conditions that may lead to situations requiring emergency or urgent medical care involving evacuation to a medical facility onshore;
- congenital malformations that result or have resulted in impaired motor function;
- mental disorders.

Parents/legal representatives are responsible for notifying the Organizer or the relevant Co-organizer of the existence of such contraindications. Failure by parents/legal representatives to notify the Organizer or the relevant Co-organizer of the existence of the above-mentioned contraindications shall constitute grounds for the Organizer or Co-organizer to demand that such persons compensate the Organizer or Co-organizer for all and any expenses incurred, related to the consequences of such contraindications, including the evacuation of the Expedition Participant. If the Organizer or Co-organizer suspects that an Expedition Participant has such contraindications, the Organizer or Co-organizer shall have the right, at its discretion, to request medical documentation from a healthcare provider and/or to exclude such an Expedition Participant from participation in the Expedition.

2.5. By the start of the Expedition, the Participants must have the following set of items to move aboard the Icebreaker: everyday clothing (T-shirts, pants, socks, underwear, warm sweaters, tracksuits, pajamas for sleeping) sufficient for ten (10) days of the Expedition (it is recommended to bring spare clothing), footwear (closed-toe shoes with non-slip soles—smooth soles are not permitted—and heel counters), and slippers (for use exclusively in the cabin or to take shower).

To move around on the open deck, Expedition Participants will need the following items: warm socks, warm pants, a wool sweater (alternative: a warm fleece jacket), warm underwear (thermal underwear), a hat, mittens or gloves, warm boots (waterproof) with ribbed, non-slip soles, a warm winter jacket, and sunglasses.

2.6. Expedition Participants must arrive at the Expedition's starting point (the exact time and location will be reported by the Organizer or the relevant Co-organizer) accompanied by attendants (made available by the Organizer or Co-organizer). By the time the Expedition starts, attendants must have a list of the Expedition Participants they are accompanying, powers of attorney from parents/legal representatives, and other documents required by these Regulations for the minor Expedition Participants they are accompanying.

2.7. Citizens of the Russian Federation who are Expedition Participants and arrive on the day of the Expedition's departure in accordance with established procedures are required to complete a manifest to board the Icebreaker (valid for a single entry; a similar manifest is required for exit), which includes verification of personal data and confirmation of crossing the borders of FSUE Atomflot. The following information is required to complete the manifest: full name, gender, date and place of birth, passport details, and nationality (Appendix No. 2 to the Regulations). The relevant Co-organizers are required to submit the completed manifest, in the form of Appendix No. 2 to the Regulations, to the Organizer no later than three calendar weeks before the start date of the Expedition.

2.8. For foreign citizens participating in the Expedition, the terms of reference for the admission of foreign citizens must be completed. To complete them, the information specified in the table (Appendix No. 3 to the Regulations) must be submitted. The relevant Co-organizers are required to submit to the Organizer, no later than ten (10) calendar days before the start date of the Expedition, a completed terms of reference form for the admission of foreign citizens, as set forth in Appendix No. 3 to the Regulations.

2.9. Electronic equipment and high-value property must be declared on a single property pass for entry/exit, issued by FSUE Atomflot. The Organizer and relevant Co-organizers shall provide information regarding the personal ownership of the equipment, specifying the brand names/models and identification numbers. The Co-organizer is required to notify the Organizer of the need to declare the aforementioned property no later than three weeks before the start date of the Expedition.

2.10. During the Expedition, Expedition Participants shall be guided by: these Regulations, the regulatory acts of FSUE Atomflot, the instructions of accompanying personnel (provided by the Organizer or Co-organizer), the instructions of FSUE Atomflot's officials, the instructions of the Icebreaker crew, and the laws of the Russian Federation.

3. ACCOMMODATION ON THE ICEBREAKER, MEALS AND MEDICAL CARE

3.1. Expedition Participants are accommodated on board the Icebreaker with two (2) Expedition Participants per cabin in accordance with the following criteria:

- Minors may not be accommodated in the same cabin as adult Expedition Participants;
- Expedition Participants of different genders may not be accommodated in the same cabin;
- Priority is given to accommodating in the same cabin the Expedition Participants of approximately the same age (with a difference of no more than one or two years) and Expedition Participants who speak the same language.

3.2. Expedition Participants' cabins are equipped with the following items: a single bed (with a set of bedding, a pillow, and a blanket) for each Expedition Participant, a bathroom with a shower stall (in each cabin) and a set of personal hygiene items (towels, soap, toilet paper, shampoo). Bedding in the cabins is changed at least two (2) times during the Expedition; towels are changed daily. Cabins are cleaned daily. Each cabin is equipped with 220V electrical outlets. A water cooler with potable water is located on every deck of the Icebreaker.

3.3. Meals for Expedition Participants are served in the dining room on a buffet basis. During the Expedition, Participants are provided with a balanced children's meal plan five (5) times a day for the entire duration of their participation in the Expedition, except for the first and last days (meals on these days are arranged depending on the start and end times of the Expedition). Meals are prepared in strict compliance with the applicable requirements of Russian Federation law, state standards and technical regulations, current occupational health and safety rules, SanPiN requirements, occupational safety requirements, and other rules and regulatory documents applicable to food service organizations.

3.4. The Icebreaker has the following premises on board: a dining room, a library, a medical office, a gym, a lecture hall, cabins, and technical rooms.

3.5. The Icebreaker is equipped with a medical office staffed with a medical professional on duty (24 hours a day).

3.6. During the Expedition aboard the Icebreaker, there are two (2) medical professionals on board who have advanced medical degrees and possess the necessary professional experience in their field (including experience working with minors).

3.7. The medical office has modern equipment and medications to provide emergency and urgent medical care to Expedition Participants. During the Expedition, measures are taken to comply with anti-epidemic protocols in order to prevent the spread of infectious diseases on board the Icebreaker.

4. RULES OF CONDUCT ON BOARD THE ICEBREAKER

4.1. Expedition Participants must exercise utmost care and caution throughout the entire Expedition. Expedition Participants are required to follow the instructions of the Icebreaker crew and attendants. On the first day of the Expedition, a safety briefing will be held for Expedition Participants on board the Icebreaker.

4.2. All movements on the Icebreaker must be accompanied by attendants or representatives of the Icebreaker crew. Expedition Participants are not permitted to move about the Icebreaker on their own.

4.3. Expedition Participants must contact the attendants or representatives of the Icebreaker crew regarding any questions that arise.

4.4. Expedition Participants must treat the property on board the Icebreaker with care.

4.5. Expedition Participants are required to treat other Expedition Participants, attendants and Icebreaker crew members with respect.

4.6. Expedition Participants are required to attend all activities held during the Expedition.

4.7. Expedition Participants must immediately report any signs of illness or feeling unwell to the attendants or the Icebreaker crew members.

4.8. Expedition Participants must adhere to the sleep and rest schedule during the Expedition.

4.9. Expedition Participants are required to select their own clothing and footwear (slippers or flip-flops are permitted in the cabin; at all other times, only shoes with heel counters may be worn) appropriate for the weather conditions during the Expedition. Expedition Participants must select clothing and footwear based on considerations of safety and comfort during their stay aboard the Icebreaker. Attendants and members of the Icebreaker crew have the right to prevent an Expedition Participant from moving about the Icebreaker, if the Participant's clothing or footwear is objectively unsuitable for the weather conditions and/or unsafe.

4.10. When moving about the Icebreaker, you must exercise caution and follow the "three-point" rule (three points of support) - a safety principle that requires maintaining three points of support to prevent falls and to ensure stability while on board the Icebreaker.

4.11. On board the Icebreaker, Expedition Participants are prohibited from using personal sports equipment without prior approval from the attendants or members of the Icebreaker crew.

4.12. Running on board the Icebreaker is prohibited. Movement about the Icebreaker is permitted only in organized groups accompanied by attendants.

4.13. It is prohibited to store personal bulky items on board the Icebreaker outside of areas specifically designated for this purpose.

5. PROCEDURES FOR THE PROCESSING AND STORAGE OF EXPEDITION PARTICIPANTS' PERSONAL DATA

5.1. The Organizer hereby guarantees that all personal data provided by Expedition Participants will be stored and processed in accordance with the provisions of the current legislation of the Russian Federation. Each Expedition Participant has the right to withdraw its consent to the processing of personal data, in whole or in part, by sending a corresponding notice to the Controller's address: 24 Bolshaya Ordynka st., 119017, Moscow. Withdrawal of consent to the processing of personal data makes further participation in the Expedition impossible, including the revocation of the Expedition Participant's right to participate in the Expedition. In such a case, the Organizer has the right to deny the Participant's participation in the Expedition. Upon receiving the notice from the Expedition Participant regarding withdrawal of consent to the processing of personal data, the Organizer is obliged to cease such processing and to ensure that any person acting on behalf of or at the direction of the Expedition Organizer also ceases such processing, and, if the retention of personal data is no longer necessary for the purposes of processing, to destroy the personal data or to ensure its destruction (if the processing of personal data is carried out by another person acting on behalf of or at the direction of the Organizer) within a period not exceeding thirty (30) calendar days from the date of receipt of such a request, except in cases where the Organizer is entitled to process personal data without the consent of the data subject on the grounds provided for by the Federal Law No. 152-FZ dd. July 27, 2006 "On Personal Data" (hereinafter referred to as the "Law on Personal Data") or other federal laws.

5.2. The Organizer and other partners acting on behalf of or at the direction of the Organizer undertake to comply with the following rules and provide each Expedition Participant with the following guarantees regarding the processing of personal data:

- to ensure that personal data is processed in compliance with all applicable requirements of the legislation of the Russian Federation in the field of personal data protection, including compliance with the principles, requirements, and obligations of a personal data controller established by the Law "On Personal Data";
- to process personal data only to the extent necessary and for the purposes of conducting the Expedition. The use and other forms of processing of personal data for the purpose of informing data subjects about any products or services, as well as for any other purposes, is permitted only to the extent and in the cases provided for by the Law "On Personal Data";
- in the event that the Organizer and other partners acting on behalf of or at the request of the Organizer, for the purpose of performing their obligations to the Participants/Expedition Participants, must transfer or otherwise disclose the personal data of Expedition Participants to third parties, they shall carry out such actions in compliance with the requirements of the Law "On Personal Data";
- to be responsible for protecting and ensuring the security and confidentiality of the Expedition Participants' personal data during its processing in accordance with the requirements of the legislation of the Russian Federation.

6. FINAL PROVISIONS

6.1. In all matters not covered by these Regulations or the Regulations Governing the "Icebreaker of Knowledge 2026" Contest (with respect to participation in the Expedition for the winners of the "Icebreaker of Knowledge 2026" Contest), the Organizer and Co-organizers shall be governed by the current legislation of the Russian Federation.

- 6.2. Being late, failing to arrive at the departure point/start of the Expedition, or failing to provide a complete set of properly executed documents will result in the Expedition Participant being disqualified from participating in the Expedition, without the possibility of receiving compensation or imposing any penalties on the Organizer and/or Co-organizers.
- 6.3. Expedition Participants travel on the Expedition without a parent or legal representative.
- 6.4. A Co-organizer sending Expedition Participants on the Expedition is obliged to ensure that the Expedition Participants are accompanied by attendants in a number and of a quality in accordance with the requirements of the legislation of the Russian Federation, or, no later than three calendar weeks before the start of the Expedition, request such attendants from the Organizer. Co-organizers sending Expedition Participants are required to independently and at their own expense provide accommodation, meals, and transfers for the Expedition Participants during their travel to the Expedition's starting point and from the Expedition's ending point to their place of permanent residence. In the event of cancellation or rescheduling of the Expedition (cl. 1.8 of the Regulations), the Co-organizer shall not be entitled to claim compensation for expenses incurred.
- 6.5. If a Participant is unable to participate in the Expedition, regardless of the reason for such inability, the Participant and his or her parents or legal representatives shall not be entitled to claim any payments or compensation, except as provided for in these Regulations.
- 6.6. The costs of obtaining all documents required by these Regulations and of taking all actions necessary to participate in the Expedition shall be borne solely by the Expedition Participants, their parents/legal representatives. The Organizer will not reimburse any expenses related to obtaining the aforementioned documents.
- 6.7. All documents/copies of documents pertaining to the parent/legal representative of an Expedition Participant, as required by these Regulations, must be provided by the parent/legal representative of the Expedition Participant who signs the documents on behalf of the Expedition Participant.
- 6.8. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Regulations until the start of the Expedition. Amendments to the Regulations shall be made by publishing a new version of the Regulations on the website <http://icebreaker.atom.online>.
- 6.9. Parents/legal representatives of a minor who is an Expedition Participant have the right to receive all information about the Expedition from representatives of the Organizer or the relevant Co-organizer.

**LIST OF MEDICAL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE
"ICEBREAKER OF KNOWLEDGE 2026" NORTH POLE EXPEDITION**

For individuals who are at least 15 years old but under 18 years old:

1. An extract from the outpatient medical record (Form 0/27-u, obtained no more than three months prior to the start of the expedition).

This document must include the following information:

- presence (or absence) of allergies, specifying the allergens (medications, food products, etc.);
 - medication use (indications, names, dosages).
2. Vaccination records (certified copy of Form 0/63)
 3. Medical certificate (Form 079/u) regarding the health status of the child traveling to a children's recreation and health camp (issued no more than three months prior to the start of the expedition).
 4. Results of a chest X-ray/fluorography (performed within the last 2 years) or a Diaskin test (performed within the last 12 months) with a conclusion from a tuberculothapist confirming the absence of tuberculosis. The tuberculothapist's report must be on the institution's official letterhead, bearing the institution's stamp, the doctor's signature, and the doctor's personal seal.
 5. A certificate of oral cavity sanitation (issued no more than 10 days prior to the date of the expedition).
 6. A certificate confirming no contact with infectious patients, issued no more than 72 hours prior to check-in at the hotel (or boarding the vessel).
 7. Compulsory health insurance policy.

For persons under the age of 15:

1. An extract from the outpatient medical record (Form 0/27-u, obtained no more than three months prior to the start of the expedition).

This document must include the following information:

- presence (or absence) of allergies, specifying the allergens (medications, food products, etc.);
 - medication use (indications, names, dosages).
2. Vaccination records (certified copy of Form 0/63)
 3. Medical certificate (Form 079/u) regarding the health status of the child traveling to a children's recreation and health camp (issued no more than three months prior to the start of the expedition).
 4. A certificate of oral cavity sanitation (issued no more than 10 days prior to the date of the expedition).
 5. Diaskin test results (performed within the last 12 months) or tuberculothapist's statement confirming the absence of tuberculosis. The tuberculothapist's report must be on the institution's official letterhead, bearing the institution's stamp, the doctor's signature, and the doctor's personal seal.
 6. A certificate confirming no contact with infectious patients, issued no more than 72 hours prior to check-in at the hotel (we recommend obtaining and submitting it strictly on the last day of your stay at home).
 7. Compulsory health insurance policy.

! Medical documents must be issued on official letterheads of medical institutions and must bear seals, stamps, and doctors' signatures. The originals must be brought with you to the Expedition.

For foreign citizens:

1. Information confirming the absence of acute conditions or exacerbations of chronic conditions (the medical certificate must be issued within the last 14 days)
2. Information regarding illnesses suffered within the last 12 months (including injuries and surgical procedures).
3. Information on chronic medical conditions.
4. Information on medical conditions that pose a threat to the individual's life and/or the health or lives of others.
